- 3 **COMPLETE 95 HOURS OF LACTATION EDUCATION**

- 4 **COMPLETE ONE OF THREE PATHWAYS TO OBTAIN
CLINICAL HOURS IN LACTATION**

- 5 **PASS THE IBCLC EXAM.**
