

There has been a change for pregnant Medicaid recipients.

As of January 2024, Nebraska has expanded Medicaid coverage for postpartum care. **Coverage has been extended from 6 weeks to 12 months after delivery** through **Legislative Bill (LB) 227**. We want to ensure that every pregnant woman receives the healthcare needed to stay healthy.

This means eligible individuals now have **continued access to essential health services** for a full year after birth including:

- Physical health care
- Mental & behavioral health services
- Dental and vision care
- Family planning services

Medicaid eligibility is reassessed after the 12-month postpartum period.

NOTE: This expansion **does not apply** to pregnant women whose coverage is through the **599 CHIP program** (based on the unborn child's eligibility).
